SAFETY ORTS:

Amarillo PD Officer Ross Renner gave safety topic on the Scan Technique::

First look at overall for impression

2nd look at hands for where are they or where are they going

3rd look at the waist band as this is most common place to carry firearms

4th look at immediate area for what is around that person that they could grab

5th look at demeanor for what state the person is in

He also mentioned to work through possible scenarios. Put yourself in a secure position. Watch the area and think through potential situations. Where are the exits. How can a situation work out? Have a plan and purpose in what you're doing.

He also recommend that everyone be familiar with Chapter 9 of the Texas Penal Code.

Texas Penal Code Chapter 9

Jeff Srygley talked about a person who had an AD (accidental discharge) in his house. He wanted to practice dry firing his conceal weapon. He unloaded it and practiced. He then reloaded it and went about his chores in and around the house. He then later unloaded it and practiced. (You can see where this is going...). At some point, he attempted a dry fire and the gun was loaded. Lesson....keep you ammunition away from the gun when you are doing dry fire practice. There should be a distinct separation.

Safety refresher orientation for existing members started in June. This safety orientation is done after the Club meeting. Many have already attended this. Be sure to make one of these sessions as this is mandatory to renew your membership in December.
