

4. Bev Stellges MYSTERY QUILT

Quilt size 58" x 74" **without** borders

FABRIC: This mystery quilt is made up of either scraps from your stash or by purchasing fabric packets or a combination! **CONTRAST! CONTRAST! CONTRAST!** There must be contrast between your light fabrics and the medium to dark fabrics. Definitely use repeat fabrics but the more variety the more interesting the quilt results. Fabrics can be prints, solids, batiks , etc. but try to avoid directional prints. Bring all your extra fabric especially if you are concerned about making errors. Backing, binding and batting are not needed in class.

Fabric amounts: Cut strips from a variety of fabrics and then cut each strip into squares listed below. Cut extras!!!!!!

- Lights: 62 (sixty-two) 4 ½" squares
- 252 (two hundred fifty-two) 2 ½" squares
- Medium to dark: 64 (sixty-four) 4 ½" squares
- 252 (two hundred fifty-two) 2 ½" squares

- Supplies:
- rotary cutter
 - rotary cutting board
 - rulers (12", 24", etc.)
 - iron and ironing board
 - scissors
 - straight pins
 - sewing machine in working order (bring manual)
 - bobbins
 - thread
 - extra sewing machine needles
 - extension cords
 - multi socket outlet
 - seam ripper
 - general sewing kit

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
