In Jesus's Name, Amen **First Lesson** Zechariah 9:9-12 9 "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.10 I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim And the horse from Jerusalem; The battle bow shall be cut off. He shall speak peace to the nations; His dominion shall be 'from sea to sea, And from the River to the ends of the earth.'11 "As for you also, Because of the blood of your covenant, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit.'12 Return to the stronghold, You prisoners of hope. Even today I declare That I will restore double to you.

<u>Second Lesson</u> Philippians 2:5-11 <u>5</u> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <u>6</u> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <u>7</u> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. <u>8</u> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. <u>9</u> Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, <u>10</u> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, <u>11</u> and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Gospel Luke 19:28-38 28 When He had said this, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.29 And it came to pass, when He came near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, that He sent two of His disciples, 30 saying, "Go into the village opposite you, where as you enter you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring it here.31 And if anyone asks you, 'Why are you loosing it?' thus you shall say to him, 'Because the Lord has need of it.' "32 So those who were sent went their way and found it just as He had said to them. 33 But as they were loosing the colt, the owners of it said to them, "Why are you loosing the colt?"34 And they said, "The Lord has need of him."35 Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. 36 And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road.37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, 38 saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
