**The History of Armistice Day**

Falling on the same day as Veterans Day, November 11th, Armistice Day takes us back to 1918 and the signing of a truce between the Allies of World War I and Germany.

The armistice, or temporary ceasefire agreement, was to last 36 days and took effect "the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the 11th month". A final treaty to end the war was signed in the following year at Versailles.

Commemoration of Armistice Day was first observed in Britain in 1919, and in many countries around the world two minutes of silence are observed at 11:00 am. For the first minute the approximately 20 million people who were killed in the war are remembered, during the second minute respect is given to those left behind who were affected by the war.

Evolved in some countries to include all veterans, fallen and living, and at times given different names, this date has

remained an important dedication to soldiers in world conflicts around the world.

In the United States in 1919 Armistice Day was proclaimed by President Wilson, and in 1938 it was made an official national holiday in dedication to the cause of world peace and to honor WWI veterans. In 1954 it was changed by congress to Veterans Day to honor all U.S. veterans of all wars.
