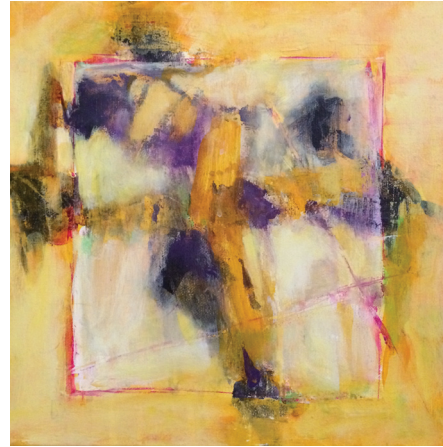

Welcome to this year's 11th Annual 'inchworks' show, appearing in our 2nd floor gallery at the Winnetka Community House, **November 16, 2017 – January 15, 2018**, with an opening reception, **Thursday, November 16, 6:30-8:00pm**.

The North Shore Art League is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to enriching the human spirit and life of its community through art education and exhibitions. Classes are offered for adults and children by the League's distinguished faculty. In addition to our main studio, the League houses a premier printmaking program. Our national fine arts juried show, **Art in the Village**, is held in Hubbard Woods Park in the bustling design district along Green Bay Road in Winnetka. The dates for our 2018 Art in the Village show are June 23rd & 24th.

Requirements:

- SIZE – Image size should not exceed 12"x12" (or any size combination no larger than 144 square inches).
- Works must be original, executed by the artist. No giclees, notecards or stationery; prints must be original. Collage or original digital images are appropriate.
- Artwork must be **framed, WIRED FOR HANGING**. If not framed, sides must be painted or finished as part of the image and wired for hanging.

- Pieces must remain for the length of the show. Sold pieces will be noted to be picked up at the end of the show.

Eligibility:

- The show is open to all artists 18 years or older who submit one or two 2D artworks.

Fees:

- \$25 members (\$35 non-members) for up to 2 pieces submitted.

Art Categories:

- Paintings: watercolor, gouache, oil, acrylic, mixed media
- Drawings: pastel, charcoal, graphite, mixed media, colored pencil
- Printmaking: monoprint, mezzoprint, drypoint, etching, collagraph and polyester lithography
- Photography
- Mixed Media

Sales:

- The North Shore Art League collects a 20% donation on the sale of any piece. The League will handle sales and remit the price, less the donation, to the artists at the end of the show.

Pick-up:

- Artwork not picked up by 2:00 on 1/16/18 will be subject to a \$10 LATE PICK-UP FEE.
