***CROWE BATTLES FOR 2nd CAREER VICTORY***

***COUREY WINS POSITION ROUND BATTLE FOR WIN # 5***

**CROWE EARNS GISBT CHAMPIONSHIP # 2**

Cameron Crowe may be known for his speed and power, but this month the southpaw from Orland Park, Illinois had to rely on his shot-making skills and his bowling savvy to return to the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 2nd time. The powerful 2-hander averaged 215 for his 8 qualifying games, but the scoring pace slowed during the finals, and the tournament's outcome hung in the balance until the final frame of the position round.

Crowe found himself locked in a low scoring seesaw battle with right-hander Isaac Erickson. The lefty needed a mark in the 10th frame, and was forced to convert the challenging 3-5-6-9 bucket combination to lock up the victory. He was up to the task, and his resulting 183-177 win was enough to grab the title. The loss dropped Erickson into 3rd place.

The champion earned his first tour victory at last season's stop in Moline, Illinois, and this month, he was appearing in his 4th match play finals.

This month's 8 boy's finalists hailed from 8 different states and represented a wide array of styles as well. The tournament lane pattern – the 41 foot Tower of Pisa – offered a stern challenge for the 84 competitors at this month's tour stop. It took a score of +71 to qualify for the boy's match play finals, and a score of just +1 to earn a check among the top 13 competitors.

Crowe averaged 210.75 for his 16 tournament games to secure the victory. He earned a \$375 scholarship and the championship check. Congratulations, Cameron!

### **PAST CHAMP MILLER EARNS RUNNER-UP FINISH**

Evan Miller turned in another great performance this month. The former tour champ vaulted from 3rd place into the runner-up spot by firing a 206 in his position round. The right-hander from Sioux Falls, South Dakota took home a \$250 scholarship for his finish, which was the 6th match play finals appearance of his career.

### **ERICKSON TAKES 3rd IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT**

Isaac Erickson was in fine form this month, and it resulted in a 3rd place finish. Erickson vaulted from 8th place into the lead midway through match play, however, his position round defeated at the hands of the eventual champ dropped him into 3rd place. The right-hander from Lititz, Pennsylvania hauled away a \$200 scholarship for his performance, which was also the first match play finish of his career on tour.

### **KRAFT RETURNS TO FINALS, FINISHES 4th**

Jacob Kraft has appeared in 2 GISBT events in his promising career, and he's qualified for the finals both times. Last month, the Casper, Wyoming native debuted on tour with a 6th place showing, and this month he returned to the finals, eventually carving out a 4th place finish; he earned \$175. Kraft, and runner-up Evan Miller are the only 2 players in the boy's division to qualify for the match play finals in both tour events so far this season.

### **QUALIFYING LEADER KYLLONEN PLACES 5th**

Ryan Kyllonen of Bethel, Minnesota, finished 5th at this month's event. The lanky 2-hander was one of 3 past champions to qualify for this month's boys finals, and he earned the high qualifier medal by posting an 8-game score of +145. From there, he eventually would finish 5th in the tightly bunched finals field to earn a \$150 scholarship.

### **DIERCKS EARNS 6th**

Alex Diercks was this month's 6th place finisher. The Cedar Rapids, Iowa resident, appearing in his 4th match play finals, hauled in a \$135 scholarship for his performance.

### **ZILK PLACES 7th**

Josh Zilk, a stocky right-hander from Virginia Beach, Virginia placed 7th at this month's tour stop. This marked the 2nd match play finals of his career, and it netted the hard-thrower a \$120 payday.

### **TACORDA FINISHES 8th**

Andrei Tacorda completed this month's boys finals field; he took home a \$110 scholarship. The Roseville, California resident was one of 3 two-handed players in this month's boy's match play finals – the 2nd finals of his promising tour career.

Colton Goodenow, from Maquoketa, Iowa, made his tour debut a successful one; he posted the highest game of the tournament – an impressive 297 in his qualifying round – and that earned him this month's \$55 high game out of the money scholarship.

## ***COUREY CAPTURES 5th CAREER CROWN***

### **COUREY BESTS NELSON FOR TITLE # 5**

In her 23rd match play finals appearance, Cassidy Courey rolled into the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 5th time. For the 2nd straight month, a position round battle between Courey and Addy Nelson determined the championship. At last month's season opener, Nelson got the best of Courey, a right-hander from Brooklyn Center, Minnesota. This time out, Courey turned the tables, prevailing with a stellar 233 game to Nelson's 187. Both ladies were in top form on the challenging lane pattern, particularly in the finals, as the duo pulled away over the final 3 games of match play.

Courey, in her final season of GISBT competition, has been one of the tour's top stars over the past 4 seasons, and this month, her \$300 winner's check bumped her career earnings to \$4,562.50 – good for 9th place on the girl's all-time career earnings list.

Courey bested a strong field of 27 girls, and this month's half-dozen finalists represented 5 different states. Courey's 5 tour victories include a pair of wins at Cedar Rapids Bowling Center; she also won there in 2018. There have been 85 different girl's champions in the 29-season history of the GISBT; this month, Courey became just the 13th to amass at least 5 tournament wins during her career. She averaged 212 for her 14 games. Congratulations, Cassidy!

### **NELSON EARNS RUNNER-UP**

Addy Nelson rolled into Cedar Rapids looking to make it 2-for-2 to begin the 2020-2021 season. Ultimately, she settled for the runner-up spot, and the accompanying \$200 scholarship. Nelson displayed sharp skills during match play, but the difference in this event was her 233-187 defeat at the hands of the eventual champ. This was Nelson's 11th match play appearance.

### **3-TIME CHAMP HESS TAKES 3rd**

Megan Hess was in solid form this month; the right-hander from Granger, Iowa rolled to a 3rd place finish, taking home a \$150 paycheck for her efforts. Hess was appearing in the 11th match play finals of her tour career.

### **WILLIAMS EARNS 4th**

Jenna Williams, a power player from Homasossa, Florida, placed 4th at this month's event. The right-hander, appearing in finals #3 of her career, took home a \$130 scholarship for her day's work; she rolled the highest game of the finals – an impressive 267 closing line – to move into 4th place.

### **URBEN PLACES 5th**

2-time tour champ Sydney Urben was this month's 5th place finisher. The right-hander from Dorr, Michigan earned a \$115 scholarship for her performance; this was the 4th match play finals appearance of her career.

### **SUNDSTROM FINISHES 6th**

Ashley Sundstrom rounded out this month's girl's finals field. The talented Cedar Rapids, Iowa resident earned a \$110 scholarship for her day's work. This was her 3rd trip into the match play finals.

Abbey Fangman earned a \$55 scholarship by having this month's high game out of the money.
