

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Leadline - Two age groups: 4 & Under, 5-7 Year Olds.

Walk-Trot - Riders 10 yrs and under who are not yet comfortable cantering in a group and who have not shown at the canter in any previous horseshow. May cross enter into any Walk-Trot class.

Mini Stirrup - Riders 9 yrs and under. May cross enter into Pleasure Pony or Short Stirrup.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Riders 11 yrs and under. Judged on the rider.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing. Judged on the rider. May cross enter Pleasure, Low/Pre-Children's or Low/Pre Adult Amateur.

Junior Equitation - Open to junior riders only. Judged on rider. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses.

Low Adult Equitation - Open to Adult Amateur riders only. Judged on the rider. Fences 2'. May cross enter Pleasure or Modified Hunters.

Adult Amateur Equitation - Open to adult amateurs. Judged on the rider. Fences 2'9".

Children's Equitation - Open to all junior riders. Fences 3'.

HUNTER DIVISIONS & PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 11 yrs and under. Judged on mount. Crossrails 18".

Modified Hunter - Open to horses or ponies, all riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'.

Low/Pre-Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. All ponies jump 2'. May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter.

Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior Riders on ponies. Judged on mount. Small/Medium ponies to jump 2', Large ponies to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Low/Pre-Children's Pony Hunter.

Low/Pre-Children's Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Judged on mount. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Children's Hunter.

Children's Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Judged on mount. Fences 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low/Pre-Children's Hunter.

Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter

Developing Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing, regardless of age.

Trotting anywhere on course permitted. Judged on mount. To jump under 18' crossrails or small verticals.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Open to all riders. Judged on mount. Ponies all to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting on corners not to be penalized.

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to any Thoroughbreds, all riders. Judged on mount. To jump 2'3".

Low Hunter - Open to horses or ponies, all riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'6".

Pleasure Pony - Open to junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount, jumps 18"-2'.

Pleasure Horse - Open to all riders on horses. Judged on mount, jumps 2'6".

Local Pleasure - Open to all riders on horses or ponies stabled within 75 miles of the Devon showgrounds. Judged on mount, jumps 2'.

EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES

Two tests will be built into the first round, no further testing:

100. M&S 2'6" Children's Medal - Open to junior riders.
101. M&S 2'6" Adult Medal - Open to Adult Amateur riders.
102. M&S Children's Pony Medal - 2' Small/Medium ponies, 2'6" Large ponies
103. M&S Children's Horse Medal - 3'
104. M&S Adult Amateur Medal - 3'

BRASS RING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

Brass Ring Championship Classes are open to horses and ponies entered in a full division at the show, and cannot be entered as a single class. The second class over fences in the division will be scored as the first round of the Championship. Open numerical scoring will be used. The top 12 scoring entries will be invited to return for a second round in reverse order.

Four Championship classes will be offered, each pinning to 8th place:

200. Short Stirrup Hunter
201. Pre-Children's Pony and Children's Pony (combined)
202. Pre-Children's Horse and Children's Horse (combined)
203. Pre-Adult and Adult Amateur (combined)

BRASS RING EQUITATION MEDAL FINALS

Open **only** to those junior riders previously qualified through pinning 1st-6th at four sanctioned qualifying shows (Freedom May 18th, Shannondell June 15th remain). Trophy and ribbons to 8th place.

Phase I: Equitation on the Flat - WTC

Phase II: Top twelve riders will be invited to show over fences.

300. Brass Ring Equitation Medal Finals for Ponies - 2'-2'3"
301. Brass Ring Equitation Medal Finals for Horses - 2'6"-2'9"

- ◆ Horse stalls are available from 6:30 am on Sunday, July 14th through the conclusion of the show on Monday, July 15th.
- ◆ Tack stalls, grooming stalls and stall assignments will be available from 3:00 pm until 6:00 pm Saturday, July 13th (...no horses yet!). Showgrounds will be open for building stabling from 3:00-6:00 pm only (...no horses yet!). Gates will close to everyone at 6:00 pm sharp!
- ◆ Bedding must be used (shavings ONLY), but WILL NOT be available for purchase at the show (bring your own shavings).
- ◆ Stripping/cleaning your stalls after the show is appreciated, but not required.
- ◆ Billing and trainer splits MUST be done in advance of picking up back numbers and cannot be adjusted on the show day.
- ◆ NO refunds of stabling for any reason after Wednesday, July 10th.

SHOW RING SCHOOLING

Schooling/medic fee is \$20.00 cash only at the gate.

SATURDAY: No horses to be ridden on the showgrounds on Saturday, July 13th! Thank you!

SUNDAY MORNING: The Dixon Oval will be open for supervised schooling from 6:30 am to 7:45 am for horses SHOWING on Sunday ONLY! This will be strictly enforced, riders must wear back numbers to be allowed into the Dixon Oval for schooling on Sunday morning. The Wheeler Ring will be closed on Sunday morning until the supervised schooling begins according to the schedule below.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON: Both show rings will be open for supervised schooling from 4:00 pm until 7:00 pm, and will follow the schedule below.

- The Horse Show Committee, the Horse Show organizers, the Devon Horse Show or property owners will not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
- Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/2018.
- ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted. No exceptions.
- The decision of a judge is final.
- No martingales to be worn in flat classes.
- The second round of the division will be scored as the first round of a Championship Class. Open numerical scoring will be used.

- Divisions will consist of three classes unless otherwise stated.
