Verde Valley Caregivers Coalition is Breaking Records

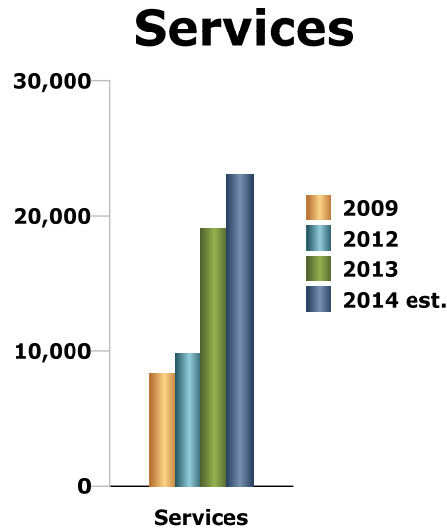

VVCC's Thrift Shop, located in Uptown Sedona, is open seven days a week and features designer clothing, children's clothing, collectibles, gifts and home décor. Thrift Shop proceeds benefit VVCC's programs and services. The Shop's revenue for 2013 was nearly \$53,000.



Guardian Angel Program

Serving 920 households in 2013, our medical alert units connect older adults, who are at-risk for falling, to family, friends and emergency services. Volunteers install the units, check them every six months, and provide maintenance. The units are loaned for as long as needed. VVCC is in the process of replacing older units with newer ones. The need for funds to replace units is on-going, along with new requests for units, which average 10 per month.
