

Reinstatement of the Bush Declaration of March 22, 1775

We, the people of the Republic of the United States of America, having adopted the Declaration of Independence in July 1776, as written by the original Thirteen Colonies that stands for equality and the Laws of Nature as God intended. We recommitment ourselves as a Republic, relying on the truths of our founding fathers as adopted in 1776. We as a people re-acknowledge and state that:

“Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, that whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.”

We, the people of the Republic of United States of America, do hereby solemnly publish and declare our allegiance to the true Republic of the United States, independent as a Nation under God. Hereby dissolve any and all other claims, treaties, alliances, voluntary and involuntary servitude, bonds and other binding instruments by any party, person or inferior trust, corporation, estate or Acts that would in its Nature change in any fashion the original intent of our forth Fathers from this day forward. This pledge is made freely in support of the Republic of the United States of America and further to return this Nation under the will of God, and treat all people of the world with the same dignity and honor as originally intended. This Declaration is accepted and acknowledge by the people to move our Nation back to our true Republic and establish new governing bodies for the Republic as the new Guard for the future of our Nation.
