- Pajamas (pants and shirt)
- Optional: Thermal underwear (long johns)

- 2 Gray Sweatshirts (recruits only)
- Moonbeam (Flashlight) with extra batteries
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Bug repellent
- Medication in original prescribed bottle and/or inhaler (in a zip lock bag with name and directions)
