Summer is here and it's HOT! Unfortunately, the club is still experiencing a shortage of volunteers, so we will notify you via email the night before, if we are forced to remain closed. It's not too late to volunteer, you can elect to work inside (with the air conditioning going full blast) or outside – we have plenty of training available and will schedule you with a seasoned volunteer.

The board of directors applied for a federal fish and wildlife gun club grant, and we were approved! The funds are to be used to build a Five-Stand and for other improvements to the skeet fields. There is a matching component to the grant; however, in-kind volunteer support can be counted toward the match. If you are able to volunteer in any capacity, please let a board member know.

4-H practice continues on Wednesday afternoons, so if you want to get in a few rounds on Wednesday evenings, the club will stay open until around 7 p.m. (or until their practice is complete).

You need to sign in at the clubhouse BEFORE you go to the field to shoot, and you must sign in EVERY visit to the range!

Safety - Do not enter a trap house without releasing the throwing arm first. Do not load your gun until you are on the shooting pad and it is your turn to shoot. Do not leave the shooting pad until you have opened your gun and cleared the empties from the chamber. **No shot larger than 7 1/2 and nothing other than lead shot.** If you see something that doesn't look safe, say something.

If at any time you have thoughts or questions for the Board of Directors, forward them to the Club email (this one) and we'll get them before the Board at the next Board meeting. Board meetings are the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 6 pm. Copies of the Board Meeting minutes are posted on the Club News bulletin board in the Clubhouse.
