## The Nice n' Easy Dance & Waltz/Foxtrot Lesson: Saturday, March 24!

The Nice n' Easy Dance and group class will be Saturday, March 24 at McAbee Center (3801 Loop Road; Tuscaloosa, 35404). This will be the third event co-sponsored by TBDC and PARA4Life, and it will indeed be a special evening: please arrive before 7 pm...

The Waltz/Foxtrot Group Class. Next Saturday, please come early to visit the admission table and change shoes for the group ballroom class that will begin promptly at 7 pm. Richard Richards and Rita Snyder will teach a Waltz pattern, giving dancers ample opportunity for practice. Then, during the second half of the class, Richard and Rita will explain how one can adapt the Waltz pattern for Foxtrot, allowing dancers to expand their repertoire for both dances. The group class will be followed by two hours of dancing, 8-10 pm, to nice n' easy ballroom standards mixed by DJ Richard.

The theme & attire: Nice n' Easy. The theme for our March dance is a tribute to Frank Sinatra's 1960 album, which held first place on Billboard's album chart for nine weeks. The songs were arranged and conducted by Nelson Riddle; and, in addition to the title song, the album included "How Deep is the Ocean," "Fools Rush In," and "Embraceable You." You can be sure that DJ Richard's music mix will include some nice n' easy Sinatra music suitable for the dance floor. In keeping with the March theme, attire for the evening will be dressy casual.

About Richard and Rita. Richard and Rita are seasoned dance instructors: they teach UA's Social Dance class, and they are the coaches for the UA Competition Ballroom Team. Richard and Rita are themselves serious ballroom competitors at the national level, ranking at the top of the amateur division for International Standard (Waltz, Viennese Waltz, Foxtrot, Quickstep, Tango).
