WHAT'S HAPPENING IN TPPC:

Member Renewals

Membership renewal is moving from December to March for next year's renewals. This change is to allow renewals to happen when members might have fewer activities and more available cash. Your current membership will be extended through March at no extra charge. There will be no mail-in renewal available. Come to either of the March meetings to renew. Fees may be paid with cash or check. We are unable to accept credit cards at this time.

Memorial Fund:

The club has started a memorial fund. The two projects we are currently planning on funding through this fund are a scholarship program and the Save Our Students project. Contact the club to donate to the fund. We have already raised \$500 for the Save Our Students project. This project will purchase door jamming devices for teachers to use in their classrooms to protect their students in an active shooter event.

If you would like to "donate" your earned club discounts to the Memorial Fund, please let us know at renewal. Regular membership is \$110. There are discounts of \$25/each for (1) Attending 7 or more meetings, (2) Attending 6 or more maintenance nights, and (3) Cleaning the lead pit 6 times in the year.

TPPC decals are available for purchase for \$1/each. Empty chamber indicators may be purchased for \$2. We also have caps available for \$10/each. We are also taking special orders for T-shirts and decals for mugs, etc.
