

discipleship in our own lives. We are also challenged to ask ourselves the question, "How well do we really know Jesus?"



July 11- Memorial of Saint Benedict, Abbot:

Benedict decided on a life of solitude at a young age. He received the monastic habit and retired to a cave. where he lived alone in the tradition of the Desert Fathers. Soon he attracted followers and he built 12 small monasteries for those who wished to share his life. Later he and a few companions founded the great monastery of Monte Cassino where Benedict spent the rest of his life and wrote his Rule which is still followed

today by the Benedictines. The *Rule* emphasizes moderation, humility, obedience, prayer and manual labour as the way to holiness. Saint Benedict is considered the Patriarch of Western Monasticism and is Patron of Europe.

Six Inspiring quotes from the 'Father of Western Monasticism'

- 'The first degree of humility is prompt obedience.'
- 'The sleepy like to make excuses.'
- 'Be careful to be gentle, lest in removing the rust, you break the whole instrument.'
- 'Run while you have the light of life, lest the darkness of death overtake vou.'
- 'Prayer ought to be short and pure, unless it be prolonged by the inspiration of Divine grace.'
- 6. 'Let all guests who arrive be received like Christ, for He is going to say, 'I came as a guest, and you received Me'. (Matt.25-35).'

July 9 - Memorial of Saint Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest, Martyr, and Companions, Martyrs: Father Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese diocesan priest who had been a soldier. It was while he was escorting a missionary priest from France that he was converted and baptized. He then studied at a seminary and was ordained. In 1815, he and 119 companions were tortured and martyred, having refused the offer of clemency if they abandoned their faith. They were canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2000.

July 13 - Memorial of Saint Henry: Known as Henry the Good. Henry II (972-1024) was renowned as a just and clement ruler, a man of prayer, and a humble ascetic. He was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III and is a patron of Benedictine oblates, childless people, dukes, kings, and the physically challenged.
