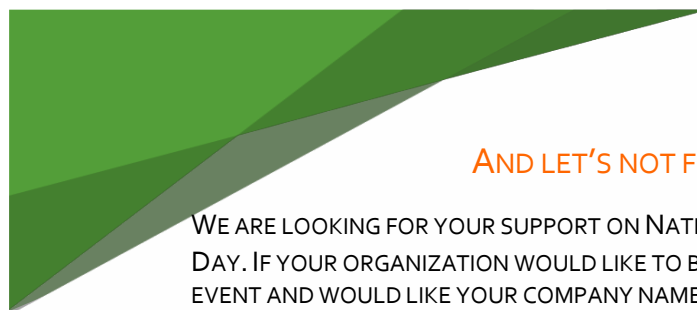
We were excited to meet and speak with such awesome students! We learned what changes they want to make in our city. Many agree that Bullying must STOP!
