Two AOH tables are reserved at the Irish Family Reunion – fifth row from the entrance of Battelle Grand Hall (at the Convention Center) on the West (right) side of the main isle.

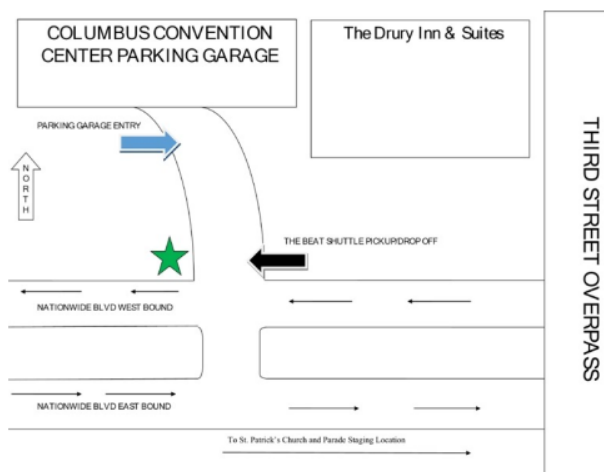

St. Patrick's Day Procession to Mass and Parade

The Procession to Mass will form at 8:30am at the corner of Naghten Street and Neilston Street. It is suggested that all drivers of passenger vehicles that are not participating in the Procession, drop people off at the corner of Mt. Vernon Avenue and Neilston Street and then proceed to the Convention Center Parking Garage on Naghten Street and then walk back to the Staging Area or take The Shuttle Bus back to the Staging Area. There will be The BEAT Shuttle Bus that will start making runs at 8:00am until 9:30am. The Cost for this service is \$1.00 per person plus the purchase or display of The 2018 Parade Badge. The Procession will step off at 9:00am and go east on Naghten Street to St. Patrick's Church at the Northeast corner of Naghten Street and Grant Avenue. **Mass will be celebrated at 9:30am.**



Upon the conclusion of the Mass, the Parade part for the Mass participants in the First- Green Division will be forming on Grant Avenue from Naghten Street to Spring Street and for participants in the Second-White and Third-Orange Divisions will be forming on Naghten Street between Grant Avenue and 5th Street.

Please follow the instructions of the Parade Marshals in lining up in the following order: 1st-The Shamrock Club's Officers, Past Presidents and Honorees, 2nd-The Glee Club, 3rd-Top Hatters, 4th-Non-Top Hatters, 5th- DOE, 6th-AOH, 7th-LAOH, and 8th-The Emerald Society.

The Parade will be forming between 10:00am until 10:45am and **will step off at 11:00am** and proceed South on Grant Avenue to Broad Street, West on Broad Street to High Street, North on High Street to The Convention Center, where the Parade will disband at the direction of the Parade Marshals.

The Shamrock Club's Irish Family Reunion will begin at Battelle Hall in the Convention Center.

Parade Route

All participants need to report to the Parade Staging Area between 10:00am & 10:45am. The Parade will step off at 1100am. Enter the Staging Area as shown on the drawing below. Have one representative of your Unit report to one of the Parade Marshals at the designated spot. They will direct your entry to the proper position.

Note: As shown below, you will enter the Parade Staging Area from Naghten Street or 5th Street. The Staging area starts at Naghten and 5th.



The Parade steps off at 11:00am:
East on Naghten St to Grant Ave;
South on Grant Ave to Broad St;
West on Broad St to High St;
North on High St to the Convention Center where the Parade will disband at the direction of the Parade Marshals.
