Summer Golf League

Every summer, El Prado Golf Courses runs a Summer Golf League (SGL), and it is bigger and better and back for its 8th year. This is not a men's club event, but many members participate every year. This year the course is inviting 72 teams to partake in this weekly competition. SGL is open to the public. All matches will be played late Wednesdays starting at 5:00 pm beginning June 3. The league is a "perfect break in the week" and "a good excuse to play golf." Whether you are a scratch golfer or new at the game, we invite you to sign up!

Each week your 2-man team will compete against another 2-man team in 9 hole match play. After the regular season, the top 8 teams from each flight will qualify for playoffs. Also, there will be an optional mystery skins game each week.
