

I can not wait to see what God has in store for my future and I look forward to one day having my very own family.

I was 5 months pregnant, addicted to heroin and completely broken on the inside when I came to Project New Start. At that time I didn't even know if I wanted to keep my baby or not. He was born 9 weeks premature and spent 5 weeks in ICU fighting for his life. Being there through all of this really opened my eyes. I didn't want to lose my son. So I prayed! Thanks be to God and the PNS staff for knowing I could do it and constantly reminding me to never give up.

As adults we understand that life "is not fair"; as adults we should understand that our life's journey is affected by the decisions we make, whether right or wrong. That being said, it is understood by adults that in this world as well as life there are issues, trials, hardships, problems and difficulties. We understand this being adults, but do we overlook the fact that in the lives of the children in our communities they too have issues, trials, hardship, problems, and difficulties; children who have witnessed violence or experienced it firsthand. Children whose innocence has been crushed by being abused mentally, physically, or sexually, and in some instances all three. Children whose idea of a "normal" home life is seeing mom and dad passed out from the influence of drugs or alcohol, or the combination of both. In most instances here at the New Life Children's Home these are the children we care for. Those whose lives are filled with "issues"; sadly, these children have not had a good role model or positive influence. What the New Life Children's Home endeavors to do is by providing the examples, guidance, and positive influence, teach the children that: "In this world (life) there will be tribulations (issues); but be of good cheer I have overcome the world." (John 16:33) This promise given by the Lord himself is to every man, woman, boy, and girl, if we will simply place our hope and faith in what Christ has done for us at the Cross of Calvary.
