Job Shadowing	<p>“Dream” scenario for Job Shadowing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reach all students who desire the experience. <p>Good: Current Better: Expand job shadowing to 8th grade Best: All students graduate with at least one exposure to workplace experience.</p> <p>Brainstorm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grow the number of students and businesses participating. Diversify student pool of participants to include all students. Students and businesses have a schedule of 2 hours, once per month available for interaction. Need to make it attractive to businesses, emphasize that they are hosting possible future employees. Use 5 Wednesday half days. Some members favored afternoon, some morning. Can job shadowing become part of the curriculum or be tracked through counselors? <p>What are reasonable next steps?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide job shadow opportunity to all students who want it. Apprenticeships at some point? Investigate what is currently offered district wide and study which courses may be able to absorb job shadowing into curriculum as a requirement.
