Leadline

Open to all children and adults incapable of riding a horse without a handler. Riders may be asked questions by the judge. Riders comfortable trotting may do so when asked.

- 44) Leadline Over Ground Poles 2 poles on the long edge of the arena. Riders may walk or trot. Handlers may circle at the beginning and end of the rider's "course"
- 45) Leadline Equitation riders will be asked to demonstrate their equitation, including a 2-point. Riders comfortable with trotting will be asked to do so on the rail. Riders will be asked to line up at the end and answer simple questions about equitation, tack and horse knowledge.
- 46) Leadline Pattern riders will be asked to preform a simple pattern based around cones. Riders may be asked to back up, preform a circle, halt, or trot if they desire.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Full payment for class fees and stabling must accompany entries. Cash, Checks or Venmo will be accepted. No credit cards. A \$50.00 surcharge will be added to all checks returned from the bank, regardless of reason. Additionally, exhibitors are encouraged to leave an open check at the horse show office to cover added classes. Otherwise, classes must be paid for as they are added.
- 2. Entries **received** (not post dated) 48 hours prior to the show date will receive the *opportunity* to have their EMT/Office fees waived for that specific show. One winner will be drawn from all pre entries.
- 3. Any accounts not paid in full by the end of the show will be assessed a \$30.00 billing fee.
- 4. Competitors paying with Venmo must check out prior to leaving or will be charged a \$30.00 billing fee
- 5. Schooling trips will be unlimited (within reason) for \$10 a trip. No ticket, no trip.
- 6. **Formal attire**. Jackets may be removed upon Judge's approval.
- Very limited stabling available. Stalls will be sold first come, first serve. PLEASE CALL IN ADVANCE TO BOOK STALLS. Stalls will NOT be sold day of show, except in emergency.

- 8. Stalls must be paid for in full a minimum of 48 hours prior to show date. Stalls paid for will be non-refundable NO EXCEPTIONS. The only way to hold a stall is to have it paid for in full, first come first serve. Stall fees will be refunded if the show is cancelled.
- 9. Bedding will be available day of show for an additional \$7 per bag. No bedding will be provided in stalls.
- 10. No overnight stabling provided.
- 11. No tack stalls may be purchased.
- 12. **Refunds:** Registrations withdrawn 1 week prior to the show date will be refunded in full. Registrations withdrawn morning of show date will have class fees and warm up fees refunded.
- 13. All exhibitors will be refunded in full if weather or safety conditions cause show to be cancelled
- 14. Proof of rabies vaccination, dated within 12 months of arrival on show grounds, and negative coggins test results, dated within 24 months of the show date, should accompany entries and payment. In addition, horses stabled outside New York state must submit a valid Health Certificate dated within 30 days. No numbers will be issued until health papers are submitted. Health papers will not be returned. Do not send originals.
- 15. THERE WILL BE A \$1.00 PER PAGE CHARGE TO COPY HEALTH PAPERS IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE.
- 16. All riders are required to wear a helmet with a harness securely fastened that meet or exceed ASTM/SEI F1163 standards whenever mounted.
- 17. Riding in the barns is prohibited.

- 18. Anyone mounted without a helmet will be asked to leave the grounds no warnings.
- 19. City View Equestrian, LLC and its employees/volunteers will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage incurred to riders, observers, horses, or equipment brought to this show. All riders are at their own risk.
- 20. Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry number. Trainers do not need to pay additional EMT/Rider fees when riding a client horse that have already paid these fees for the day. Trainer must ride with the entry number of the rider/horse on the entry form.
- 21. High Points are awarded based on the entry number. Champion and Reserve prizes and ribbons will be awarded in all divisions in which 3 or more entries compete in a majority of the classes.
- 22. No champion or reserve awards will be handed out in divisions with 2 or less riders

- 23. Horses may arrive at the show grounds after 6am on day of show. The indoor arena will be open at 6am for schooling. The show arena will be open at 7am for schooling and close at 8:30am to prep for the first class.
- 24. Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses in the show/schooling arenas at one time.
- 25. There will be no lunging of horses in any of the outdoor arenas. Lunging may be done in the indoor only. Lunging horses will have the right of way in the indoor. Mounted riders must exit when horses are being lunged in the indoor. Riders may lunge in the back field at your own risk.
- 26. Riders under 18 are not allowed to ride stallions.
- 27. Weather delays will only be held until 11am on scheduled day of show. Show will be cancelled if class #1 does not start before 11am. Rain dates will be posted.
- 28. The decision to divide, combine, move or cancel a class will be at the discretion of show management. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes with less than 6 entries. Classes will be split at the discretion of show management.
- 29. Bedding may be purchased through Mary Corke (585)386-9338. Please include additional bedding fees on entry forms.
- 30. No dogs on the property

- 31. NO SMOKING ANYWHERE ON THE PROPERTY
- 32. Trailer parking will be determined by parking assistants. Parking available in large, grass field at BACK of property, passed the show arena. No parking by the barns or houses will be permitted. Parking on the road is discouraged. Vehicles violating our parking terms will be towed.
- 33. Management reserves the right to deny service to anyone violating Copy Right laws on our photographer's work. Social media accounts using watermarked photos that have not been purchased will NOT be permitted to show on our grounds. Riders using watermarked photos will forfeit all their points (and will not receive them back even after payment is received). Riders using watermarked photos will not receive ribbons or paybacks. Riders using watermarked photos will not receive year end awards.
- 34. A staffed veterinarian will be on call for drug testing. Horses found with illegal substances in their bodies will be reported to the appropriate breed or discipline affiliation.
