FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners

The season of Advent is almost upon us! Advent is the beginning of the Church's liturgical year, and offers us a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. In light of this, I concluded that Advent would be an appropriate time to make a few **changes to the daily Mass schedule** here at Our Lady of Good Counsel. These changes are being made after several weeks of observation of the attendance at daily Mass and seeking consultation with many of those who attend Mass throughout the week. **Beginning with the days following this First Sunday of Advent, November 28th, the following schedule will go into effect:**

Monday: No Mass

Tuesday-Friday: Mass at 12:05pm

*The First Friday of each month an additional Mass will be offered in Spanish at 6:00pm (Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:30pm, concluding with Benediction before Mass)

*The First Saturday of each month Mass will be offered at 9:00am in English (Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 8:30am, concluding with Benediction before Mass)

As for the reasons behind the changes: cancelling the morning Mass on Monday provides me with the opportunity to rest as well as to travel and visit family and friends on my day off. Please know that I still offer the Mass privately on my day off, wherever I may be. In regard to the Mass on Tuesday, I made the decision to change it to 12:05 for the sake of consistency, and because the afternoon Mass has been much higher in attendance. As the Mondav and Tuesdav Masses are a more recent addition to the parish schedule, I trust that this will not be seen as a drastic change. Lastly, I want to reintroduce the additional Masses on the first Friday and first Saturday of every month, which are days devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. These days of devotion are very important for the spiritual life of the parish and for each one of us individually. I want to thank you for your understanding in regard to these changes, and may God bless you!


