PASTOR'S LENTEN MESSAGE

Even now," declares the Lord, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning." (Joel 2:12)

Dear Friends, This Wednesday, the day of abstinence and fasting, we will gather at our Church to celebrate Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the season of Lent. Lent is 40 days long (plus Sundays) and prepares us for Holy Week and the Lord's Resurrection. It is a time of sober selfreflection.

"I invite you, therefore, in the name of the Church, to the observance of a holy Lent, by selfexamination and repentance; by prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy "Word." (1979 B.C.P., p. 265)

Now is the time to turn to Jesus as never before. St. Joseph's Church is spiritually vital and strong only when we as Christians walk closely with the Savior. Our church depends on the observance of a holy Lent. None of us is perfect and despite outward appearances there is brokenness in all of our lives. Each Lent is an opportunity for growth as a human person as a follower of Jesus. It calls us to reflect in honesty and humility on our brokenness—but not only on the brokenness, but on the grace and mercy and forgiveness of God who wants no more than to grace what is broken in our lives.

We are called to die to the old, to the comfortable, to the sinful in our lives in order to rise to something new. This is what our ashes mean. They are not a badge of honor but an outward sign of our humble acknowledgement of our need for God's grace. They are a sign of our willingness to once again make room for that grace, and to allow it to transform us.

We each need Lent as an opportune time to empty ourselves to make room in our lives for that specific grace God offers to each of us as beloved sons and daughters.

Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are pillars of Lent. Try to do one thing daily in each of these categories. Stretch yourself a bit out of old routines and come up through prayer with something new and challenging to yourself.

Place Lenten reminders around your home. Consider moving your crucifix at home to a new place to make it especially visible. Find a special picture or holy card that speaks to you and display it.

Plan to come with family and friends for DAILY MASS in Lent, and to the Stations of the Cross every Friday in Lent at our Church after the 8:30 am Mass.







NCE BASED ON THE TEN

A BRIEF EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE BASED ON THE TEN COMMANDMENTS:


