I understand that the sport of Horse Riding is a high-risk sport and that my participation in this educational activity may also involve participation in an "equine activity" as defined by applicable laws and is wholly at my own risk. I understand that my participation involves all inherent risks associated with the dangers and conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to, the property of equines to behave in ways which may result in injury, harm of even death to humans and other animals around or near them; the unpredictability of equine reaction to sounds, sudden movements, smells, and unfamiliar objects; persons or other animals; hazards related to the surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other equines or objects; and, the potential of a participant to act in a negligent or unskilled manner which may contribute to injury to the participants or others, including falling or inability to maintain control over the animal. By participating in this activity I agree to assume responsibility for those risks, and I release and agree to hold harmless, Encore Stables, LLC., its event organizer, management, staff, trainers, boarders, and students or anyone associated with the facility, liable for any injuries to me or my horse.

All riders are required to send in a biography of themselves and their horse and must be submitted with their registration form. Please fill out the attached registration form including your preferred fence height. A non-refundable deposit of \$200 is required along with your stall payment (if needed).

You will be contacted via email with confirmation of your clinic spot or if you are on the waitlist. Those placed on the waitlist will have their deposit check sent back to them and will not require payment unless they are able to ride in the clinic due to another's cancellation. Approximately 2 weeks before the clinic you will be notified of your group riding time. If you must cancel your riding spot, your stall check/reservation will be refunded, but your deposit will not. Auditors are also required to pre-pay the full amount. Auditors are required to check in the same as riders to get their hand stamp/wrist band.

The clinic will be held in our outdoor ring. The indoor ring will be available for schooling. Following the conclusion of the last session, the outdoor ring will be closed for dragging and setting of the course for the next day. Riders should be appropriately attired including clean tack and equipment. Riders are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted. Horses should be clean and properly dressed for the sessions as well.

For TCP credit there will be round table discussions after last session on the 12th and during lunch break on the 13th

Food will be available for purchase for breakfast and lunch each day. Dogs are not permitted for insurance and safety reasons. The clinic will still run if raining. Should there be a forecast of storms more info will be sent out to those participating.

NOTE:

Please no flash photography while the clinic is in session. All devices must be silenced during the clinic as well.

The clinician has the right to dismiss any horse/rider which has chosen an inappropriate fence height. Refunds will not be given for improperly chosen sections. Please choose the appropriate section, you may be asked to give proof such as USEF records.

Julie Winkel, of Reno, Nevada, owns and operates Maplewood Stables, Inc., and is a trainer, judge and popular clinician. She's trained and shown hunters and jumpers to the top levels, nationally and internationally, and has had many grand prix wins and hunter championships throughout her riding career.

She's presided as a Licensed USEF Judge over many of the best shows in the country, including Devon, the Pennsylvania National, the Washington International, the National Horse Show, Capital Challenge, The Hampton Classic, Upperville, the U.S. Pony Finals, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championships to name just a few. She has been judging for over 30 years.

Julie is also a respected course designer and has judged the New England Equitation Finals, the ASPCA Maclay Finals, the USEF Medal Finals (in 2007 with Geoff Teall, in 2010 with George Morris, and with Scott Hofstetter in 2015).

Julie gives back to the sport in a variety of ways, including generously volunteering her time to the USEF and USHJA, including as a past member of the USHJA Board of Directors. She's currently co-chair of the USEF Licensed Officials Committee, chair of the USEF Continuing Education and chair of the USHJA Judges Task Force. She's also a member of the USHJA Zone 10 Jumper Committee. Julie also writes the monthly column "Conformation Clinic" for Practical Horseman magazine.

In between her travels, Julie oversees her Maplewood, a 150-acre training, sales and breeding facility. Maplewood also stands two stallions, the grand prix jumpers Osilvis and Cartouche Z.
