Tuesdays, 3:30-6 p.m.

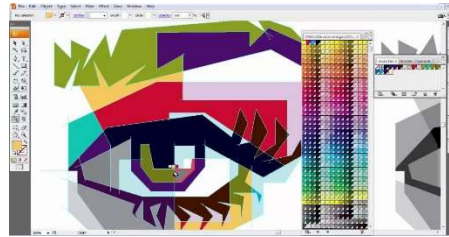
