These four babies were soft and pink (hold up one hand, four fingers up)


These four babies were black as ink (hold up other hand, four fingers up)

Our mittens we have found!" "What! Found your mittens,







Two little hands and ten little fingers, Two little hands and ten little fingers, Two little hands and ten little fingers, Count them all with me.
