

Kids' Summer Story Time

Ms. Sue walked the group to the promenade so she could show them where the tundra swans come to the bay during the winter. The craft was a swan cut from recycled gift boxes and the kids traced their hand to create the swan’s “wings.” The snack was a marshmallow peep (pretending it was swan) sitting on a nest of chow mein noodles (swans make their nests from twigs, moss, and grass).
