Our first club sponsored saltwater trip is past! The other trips are filling fast and a lot have standby only. I'm looking to possibly book the Endeavor, Tucker McCombs new boat out of Ventura. I'm doing this for 2 reasons. One, it is always good to have another boat to fish and I want to extend our season past August into September or October and 2 there is a rumor the Pacific Dawn MAY move to San Diego year-round! As Tucker now owns the Endeavor, I am negotiating with him for June, July and August dates on board the Endeavor in hopes of getting a good shot at the White Sea bass!

Our trips are closing and beginning to fill up <u>FAST</u>. The June Dawn, Sea Jay and Betty O are full, but I will take STANDBYS, while the Pacific Dawn April Trip and Fury July Trip have one spot left. Time to sign up! 
# **Whopper Board Reminder**

Well as usual, the trip was a little hard to sell. We had Glen Bummer, William Davis, Ron Hall, Sam Zanrosso, Mike Maurizio, Randy Kroll, Eric Kroll, Chuck Auer, on board from the club. Don Udlock and Bob chiavelli dropped out due to illness and were replaced by Wayling Lueng, Kenny Lueng, and John Heary all of whom have fished with us before and I hope will join the club. Pat asked for two spots for Brandon and son Shane Thomas. I filled out the boat with fishermen who came all the way from Bakersfield Jacob Fritz, Shawn Fritz, Adam Wren, Scott Richardson and Walter Griffin. Walter drove all the way from Bakersfield to tell me he was ill but would still go on the trip. I sent him home.

The ride over was a little shaky but very loud. Waves were hitting the boat and you could hear them in the bunkroom. The day was overcast, and Mike did not see squid going over, so we decided to Rock Fish. We fished deep, at least everyone else did. For the first time in about 30 years I was actually sick. I sat out the morning session. Beautiful Reds and Ling Cod came over the sides all day. Everyone was bringing up fish on the double dropper loops. I watched the techniques of my fellow anglers and was amazed how Glen Bummer just stood there stoically, bringing up one fish after another on a single speed reel. His technique was awesome. Little or no wasted motion or energy. I salute him! The others were having a great day with the white fish, reds, lings and other species. The weather was overcast and a little windy. By the third move I was feeling well enough to fish and caught a few small ling cods, white fish and reds. I didn't get skunked. I lost a Magic Mikey as I call it, a prized lure I got from Mike Maurizio and one of Captain David Bacon's Halibut Jigs when I snagged bottom.

Sacks were filled and we moved around looking for any signs of yellowtail and white sea bass, not knowing other boats were all over them earlier that day. The boats never let Mike know about the "bite." We fished for halibut and white fish when we reached our quota of Reds and Lings. All and all a successful first outing of the year.

By the way, Glen Bummer with his tried and true equipment and methods beat out Ron Hall to win the Club's biggest fish. Our guest Jacob Fritz took the Jackpot for the boat. It was a good trip and a great way to begin the saltwater season. Congratulations Glen on a job well done!
