

Quilt blocks from the following shops are shown in the photograph, reading left to right, top to bottom: *Top Border corners:* Knotty Stitches; Paisley Duck.

1st row: Sherry's Cozy Quilts; Longview Sewing & Kitchen; Annie's Quilt Shoppe; Heavenly Quilts and Fabrics Redeemed; Casey's Crafts; Quilters Workshop.

2nd row: Quilted Strait; Carriage Country Quilts; Esther's Fabrics; Calico Creations; Quilting Mayhem; Tangled Threads Quilt Store.

*3rd row:* Ben Franklin Crafts – Bonney Lake; Gathering Fabric Quilt Shop; Fiddlesticks Quilt Shop; Calico Country; Running Stitch Fabrics; A Plus Sewing.

*4th row:* Bigfoot Quilts; Quilted Treasures Studio; Sew Hip; Folktales; Creative Union Fabrics; The Quilting Fairy. *5th row:* Pieced Together Quilts; Kori's Fabric Creations; Sister's Quilt Shop; Shibori Dragon; Just for Fun! Quilting; Gee Gee's Quilting.

6th row: Gossypium Quilt Shop; A Stitch in Time Quilt Shoppe; Front Porch Quilts; Ben Franklin Crafts – Monroe; The Shiplap Quilt Shop; Ben Franklin Crafts – Redmond.

Bottom Border corners: All Things Sew; The Quilt Barn.

# Instructions for finishing the Shop Hop 2022 Quilt

40 Shop Hop blocks are used in this quilt. Finished quilt size: 75" x 75" • Finished block size: 8" x 8"

#### **Materials**

(Yardages are based on 40" usable fabric width, after prewashing fabric and trimming selvages.)

- 1¾ yds. Shop Hop 2022 purple plaid (222SH-1) for sashing strips
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd. Shop Hop 2022 green leaves (223SH-1) for cornerstones

1 % yds. Shop Hop 2022 fruit labels (Y3257) for border

<sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> yd. for binding [The Shop Hop 2022 purple plaid (222SH-1) was used for the poster quilt.]

5 yds. for backing

## Cutting

From Shop Hop purple plaid, cut:

• 84 rectangles, 2" x 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", for sashing strips

From Shop Hop green leaves, cut:

• 49 squares, 2" x 2", for cornerstones

From Shop Hop fruit labels, cut:


• 4 strips, 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x length of fabric, for borders (These are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

From binding fabric, cut:

• 8 strips, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40", for double-fold binding

## Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Sew sashing strips and cornerstones, and sashing strips and Shop Hop blocks, together in horizontal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram; then join horizontal rows together. Press all seams toward sashing strips.
- Measure width of quilt top through center. Trim 2 border strips to this measurement. Sew a corner block to each end of both strips as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward border strips.
- 3. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim the remaining 2 border strips to this measurement and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

4. Sew borders, made in Step 2, to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

#### **Finishing**

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.

This year 6 coordinating prints were designed especially for the Western Washington Quilt Shop Hop. The Shop Hop 2022 fruit labels print and a coordinating berry print were designed by Clothworks. Four coordinating Shop Hop 2022 go-with prints (including the purple plaid and green leaves) were designed by In The Beginning Fabrics. Look for all of these prints at your favorite quilt shop!
