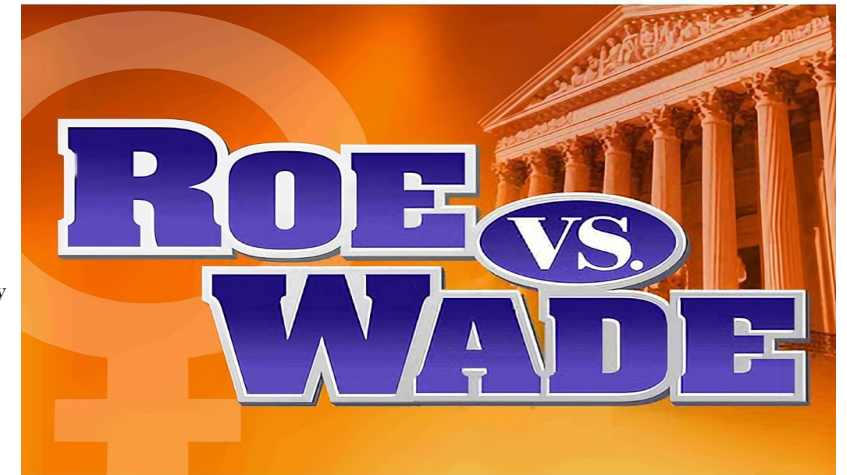

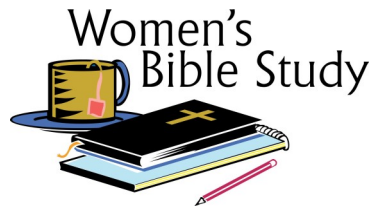


Some have expressed that they are not receiving the church e-mails. If this is the case with you, please give your email address to Jack or Becky and they will try to correct this.

Our own Drew Stafford will be speaking at the Montrose VBS, Monday, July 11th. Let's plan to support him.

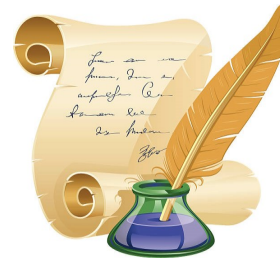
"Let your faith be bigger than your fears."
