In 2020, we will pass the \$500,000 mark in scholarships awarded to Touchet High School graduates since 2003!

Some fantastic statistics to share:


In 17 years, 81% of Touchet seniors (303 out of 376) have applied for and received TEF scholarships. Awards have been \$451,430.

Since 2008, we have also awarded scholarships to 56 past Touchet graduates as they continued college. These awards total \$41,500.

Since TEF began in 2003, Touchet kids have gone on to earn bachelors and advanced degrees from Boise State University, Boyd School of Law, Central Washington University, Eastern Oregon Uni-

versity, Eastern Washington University, Evergreen State College, Gonzaga University, Lewis-Clark State College, Oklahoma State University, Oregon Institute of Technology, Rocky Mountain College, University of California Davis, University of Idaho, University of Nevada Las Vegas, University of Portland, University of Puget Sound, University of Washington, Walla Walla University, Washington State University, Westpoint, Western Oregon University, Western Washington University, Whitman College, and Whitworth University.
