


This fall we will be assembling school kits to send to Lutheran World Relief to give to those affected by natural disasters and poverty.

- 1 blunt scissors (example: safety scissors with embedded steel blades)
- 5 unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- 5 black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink)
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 2 1/2" pin eraser
- 1 sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag about 14X17" with shoulder straps (no standard backpacks)






