## DIXIE DEER SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL BOARD MEETING OF WEDNESDAY March 20, 2024, at 7:00 P.M.

- 1. CALLED TO ORDER: At 7:00. (Chairman) Jim Rowles called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He then led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag
- 2. OPENED: REGLULAR MEETING: We have five Board members in attendance at tonight's meeting (Chairman) Jim Rowles; (Vice Chairman); Jason Ranoa; (Clerk) Jan Hamilton; (Treasurer) Lauri Marsh; (Director) Wes Peterson. (Water Master) Wayne Gudgell and (Admin assistant and Scribe) Susan Gudgell. (GUESTS). We had 14 Resident and 5 Non-Resident Guests signed in for tonight's meeting.
- 3. CLERK'S REPORT: Jan Hamilton began her clerks report by saying she felt that the finances looked good. Wes moved to approve the clerk's report and Jason seconded it. All in favor Unanimous.
- 4. TREASURER'S REPORT: (Treasurer) Lauri Marsh began her report by stating that the General account has (\$44,823.84), the Rural Development account has (\$7,916.00), the Cap. Imp Reserves count (\$68,795.52), the Utah Division of DW Reserves has (\$59,870.45), the 10yr Pmt. Reserves P.T.I. F. accounts have (\$69,619.31), P.T. I. F. total Accounts are (\$198,285.28). For a grand total of (\$251,025.12). Jim moved to approve the Treasurer's report Jason seconded it. All in favor. Unanimous.
- 5. PREVIOUS MONTH'S MINUTES: Board members reviewed the minutes of the February 21,2024, Board meeting. Jan moved to accept the minutes Jim seconded it. All in favor, Unanimous.
- 6. APPROVE P&P UPDATE RESOLUTION: #20240320; Jim gave a brief history of DDSSD Policies and Procedures (P&P) leading up to this 2024 rewrite and previous review in Board meetings. The Resolution, #20240320, was approved and

signed. Jan moved to accept the Resolution and Wes seconded it. All in favor Unanimous.

- 7. FINALIZE CONVEYANCE OF 15 A.F. WATER TO BIVINS FROM HIS "BANKED "31.75" A.F. Jim explained the Water Rights background that resulted in Bivins Brothers having the right to withdraw 15 Acre Feet of his 'banked' water rights from the Dixie Deer WR 81-529. The Board agreed to sign the Water Deed when it is approved by our legal counsel.
- 8. Mr. JASON ROGER'S TO REQUEST EXTRAERRITORAL WATER: Jason Rogers was the person representative of the Richard Hafen Family. Asked if we would /could supply water for future developments within their acreage along Pine Valley Highway. The Board needs a project plan before the Board says yes or no to any water agreement.
- 9. WATER MASTER'S REPORT: Wayne began his report by stating that last month we pumped 1,488,210 gallons of water. This averages out to be 47,865 gallons of water a day. Wayne will read meters on Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup> and stuff envelopes Friday the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 10. Public Discussion. Five residents expressed their opinions and issues on the actions the Board is taking, and they were acknowledged. The Board will take the opinions/issues into consideration as we move forward. Closed meeting announcement.
