Creating Your Own Ad?

Here are some basic guidelines for creating your own billboard layout.

- Suggested scale for all vinyl production is: ½"=1'
- Please add .25" around all sides for bleed (this will make a 6" bleed on the billboard vinyl)
- Keep critical elements .25" away from the edge of the live area of the layout.
- All elements and photographs should be at least 300dpi at ½" =1' scale. Optimal output is up to 408ppi, so there is no need for anything larger.
- For the most accurate color-reproduction, please include all PMS color callouts for each element of your design.
- If possible, convert all text to outlines to eliminate any font matching errors. Include the font files anyway, just in case we need to make changes.

Guidelines for creating your own digital billboard layout.

- Our board has a resolution of 1044 pixels wide by 324 pixels tall for an aspect ratio of 29:9.
- Your copy will look better if it is in this native resolution.
- To avoid image distortion please make your image the native aspect ratio.
- Image files should be smaller than 1 megabyte, otherwise they will be resized.
- Images can be in most common image formats such as .jpg or .png.

What Program Do I Use to Submit My Art?

- Our production facility prefers a .pdf file (with all type converted to paths) or a flattened Photoshop, .tif or .jpg file
- If you want Sun Outdoor to be able to modify or make minor corrections or changes to your art if necessary, you will need to submit your art to us in one of these options (make sure to convert text to outlines or include all fonts with your submission)
