SUMMARY:

Manages the plant layout and facility diagrams. Estimates costs related to layout design, including equipment and materials, labor, etc., and monitors the construction process. This position involves working with staff, shift leaders, and the hourly workforce.

- Liaison with all departments and other engineering and production colleagues to improve communication.
- Controlling maintenance tools, stores and equipment.
