Summary:

Guy #3 leads out the time by turning to Daniel chapter 3,

Guy #3 begins to read aloud and voice fades to music....

Music begins to play,

3 Guys do dance routine moves, **King** enters with idol demanding guys to worship,

3 Guys refuse to bow down and worship idol, King orders them to be thrown into furnace alive,

Angel comes with extinguisher to cool the flames, King is taken aback and recognizes LORD of Heaven

- 3 Guys are having a blast in the flames, drinking, toasting,
- 3 Guys come out and continue dance moves,

Music stops and scene is transported to devotion time,

Guy #1 exclaims, "boy, I all fired up now..." 3 Guys exit stage...
END

MORAL OF THE STORY: Excellent for the theme of "No Fear, No Compromise!"; that the Christian life is not boring nor a dead religion but teaches the faithfulness of young men and women.





