A few weeks ago I was away at the Mid-West St. Michael's Anglican Youth Bloomfield Conference in Hills. Michigan. Currently there are two St. Michael's Youth Conference's: Mid-West in Bloomfield Hills Michigan, and South-West in Fort Worth, Texas. Both Conferences provide a week-long retreat for ages 12-20. The goal of St. Mike's is that the Conference, with its schedule of daily Morning Prayer, Solemn High Mass, classes, activities, Evensong, and Compline will inspire a deeper faith in our vouth. After attending Conference for three years the Conferee is given a St. Mike's Medal and ideally be ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

This year was my 9th year attending the Conference and my 5th year as a priest on staff. I officiated Morning Prayer, Evensong and Compline occasionally throughout the week, and was honored to celebrate Mass that Friday, I also cotaught two classes, an Introduction to the Bible, and a senior level Apologetics class. St. Mike's is definitely not a vacation for us priests, but we all agree that it is one of the best weeks of the year!
