

Parent Code of Behaviour

Remember that children play the sport for their enjoyment, and not yours.

Encourage children to participate and have fun.

Focus on the child's effort and performance rather than winning or losing.

Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.

Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.

Remember that children learn best by example, so applaud good play by both teams.

Support all efforts to remove racial and religious vilification, verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.

Do not smoke or consume alcohol near the Team bench (Technical Area) or sideline.

Respect the match official's decisions and teach your child to do likewise.

Show respect and appreciation to Club officials, including coaches, administrators and the opposing team officials.

All club registration fees must be paid in accordance with the terms/conditions set out by the Committee.

Ensure any issues are raised through the correct channels. Firstly consult your Coach/Team Manager, should you feel this is unsuccessful you are welcome to write to the committee and request a meeting Committee.

If the club is charged with bringing the game into disrepute and is fined, the offender will be liable for any cost imposed on the club.

The Committee has the right to expel or suspend any parent/guardian or player from the club if they breach any of the above guide lines.
