Father Sam's Corner 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Gospel: Mark 10:2-16

A Childlike Heart Enhances Good Relationship

Jesus enjoined his followers today in the Gospel that they must apply a childlike mind in their witness to his Gospel to enhance their relationship with God and chance of salvation. A reminder of the characteristics of a child's mind can enrich our quick grasp of this message. Let us pause a while to try to answer the question why it takes only a few minutes for two children who engaged in a fight to make up and become good friends again, but it takes forever for some two adults to make up with each other in the same situation? I think the reason is that the hearts of children retain more joy, love, obedience, humility, serenity, forgiveness and trust than adults' hearts. For the fact that children are more innocent, obedient, humble and forgiving than many adults, they mend broken fences of their friendship faster, and enjoy a happier friendship/relationship with God and others. No wonder Jesus said today in the Gospel that the kingdom of God belongs to children and enjoined his disciples to be children in heart in matters of the kingdom of God (Mark 10:2-16). This is to say that the kingdom of God belongs to those who have a childlike heart.

The above divergent conditions of human minds can be seen in Adam and Eve's minds with regard to their relationship with each other and God as captured in the first reading. Deducing from the story of this Sunday's first reading one can opine that Adam and Eve had a childlike heart at the beginning of their relationship with each other and God. Thus, before their fall Adam and Eve obeyed God like little children. Because of their total obedience to the words of God, they were united in love so much that Adam could describe his wife (Eve) as: "bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh" (Genesis 2:18-24). Then when they disobeyed God, they started pointing accusing fingers to each other. This means total obedience to the will and law of God enhances unity and good relationship between husband and wife and man and God. But breaking of divine law or will brings division and separation between husband and wife and between man and God.

Consequently, Christ has the above picture of the cause of the unity and disunity between Adam, Eve and God in mind when he stated that from the beginning marriage is meant to be a permanent union between a man and a woman (Mark 10:6-8): until the two stopped following the will of God and start to do their own will. Hence, because of the disobedience that is part of the weakness of the adults' minds, Adam and Eve surrendered to the voice of Satan and questioned God's law, disobeyed God and blew their relationship up. We are not saying that kids do not ask questions. No, they ask a lot but when you give them answer they believe and accept it. We are not talking of teenagers here but small kids. We can see that Adam and Eve enjoyed their relationship with God and one another in the garden throughout the periods they humbled themselves and obeyed God's commands like every good child. But immediately they started to question and doubt the validity of an aspect of the Divine rules like adults, they disobeyed God, injured their relationship with God, marred their happiness and were thrown out of the Paradise.

Christ enjoined his followers today to always apply the heart of a child in the matters of heaven and marriage relationship. Application of a childlike heart in matters of the kingdom of God means we should obey and trust more of the revealed messages of God. Just like a child who after questioning and getting explanations, out of trust and obedience resigns to his parent's will and power, God wants us to behave like that in the matters of His kingdom. Hence, the more we obey God and do his will, the more we enjoy peace and unity in our marriage relationship and in our relationship with God. But the more we disobey the commandants and do our will the more our marriage relationship or relationship with God suffers. We have many broken divine and marriage relationships because of lies, unfaithfulness, etc. Consequently, where we have any of these vices, law or laws are broken. Additionally, God wants us to find more reason in our hearts to forgive when others offend us like kids. For we need to have a childlike heart in the face of the kingdom of God to enter it.
