Tuition, Classes, Pricing

Burlington Dance Academy (BDA) runs in 8 & 12 week sessions. Session 1, September & October. Session 2, November-January. Session 3, February-April. Session 4 May & June. Tuition is due by the 15th of the first month of each session. Late payments incur a \$5 fee. Monthly payments are offered if signed up for autopay, along with an additional 4% convenience charge. All payments can be put directly into the black lock box, please do not give to the teachers. Students wishing to add or drop a class must fill out an add/drop form. This must be done within 2 weeks of starting or stopping a class. Failing to do so, will forfeit your session tuition. Refunds will be given upon receiving the completed form. When students miss a class they are entitled to a make-up in any class of their choice. This must be used within the current session, or one month after the missed class. If class is cancelled due to weather, students are also allowed a make-up, which does not expire until the end of the dance year. Please watch BAND, Facebook & Instagram regarding cancelations. BDA will be closed if Burlington School District cancels school, or after school activities at the High School. Cancelled classes may be rescheduled at teacher's discretion.
