Mike Sabat reported that Smallbore shooting is continuing and they are sending their targets in for scoring. Regular shooting days will be on Wednesdays. Anyone wanting to join should contact Mike Sabat or Greg Paff.

Dan Grey reported that Youth Archery will be starting on January 14<sup>th</sup> and will be on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of the month. We have bows in small, medium and large sizes and all children are welcome.

Dan Charles reported that Youth Shooting for ages 7-16 has started. Ammunition and rifles are supplied by the club at no charge. Parents do not have to be members for children to attend. Youth Shooting will be on the first and third Saturdays of the month and will continue through May. At the last session on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 9 children attended.

Tony McClure reported the Ladies Night sessions will be starting on January 3 and will be on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays of the month from 7-9 PM through June. Flyer will be sent out to show equipment needed for these sessions.
