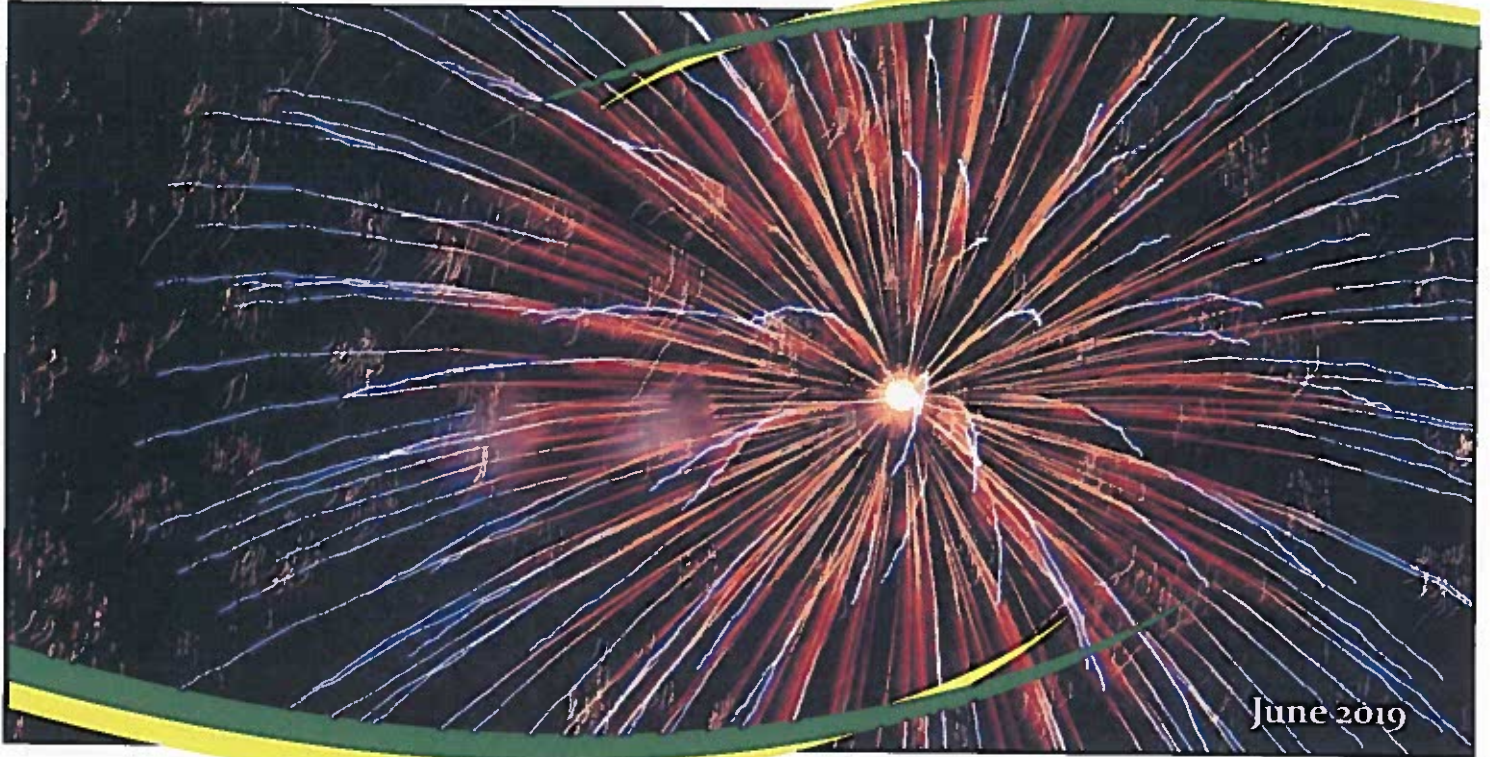

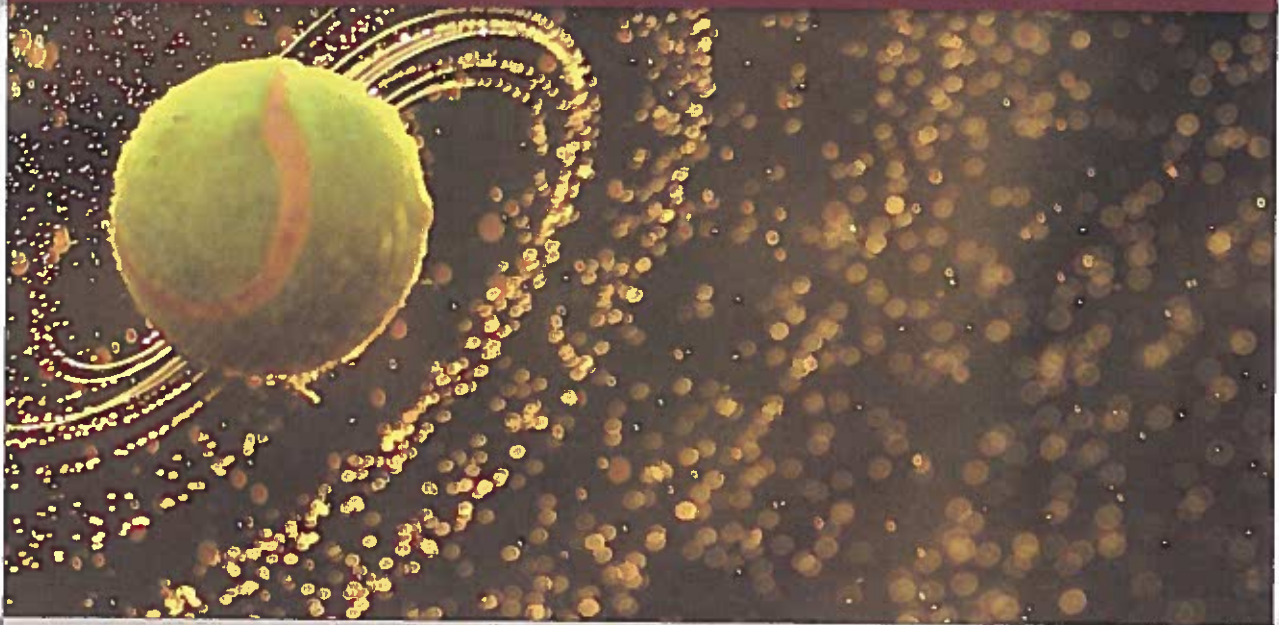

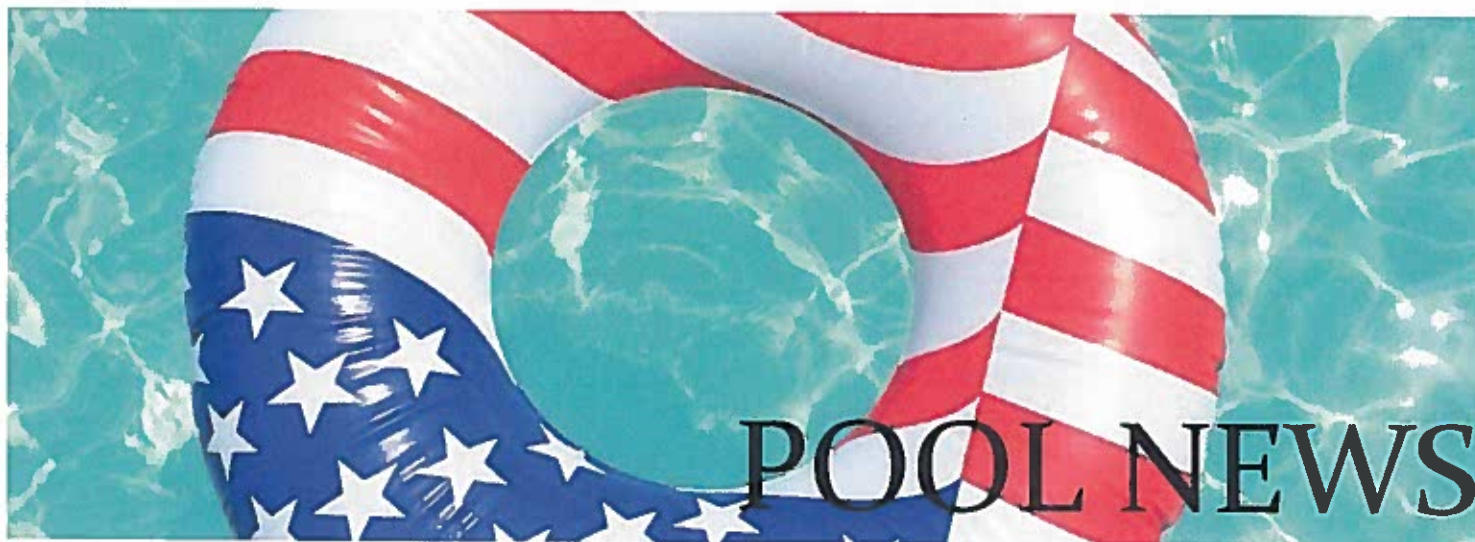

## July Pool News

We are heading into the second full month of summer and want to encourage everyone to come visit the pool and enjoy this beautiful part of the club. The pool water is clean, inviting and the water temperature is averaging 82 degrees.

### SIGN IN

Please be patient when signing in at the desk as the lifeguards are required to write certain information down for the club's record keeping. This is also to protect your account from being used by unauthorized people.

### GUESTS

When bringing guests to the pool these options apply,

- 1) Someone from the member's family brings the guests.
- 2) The member must call the pool ahead of time telling us that they have guests coming and to charge their account.
- 3) If a guest comes without you and no prior phone call is received, we will have the guest call you and let us speak to you to gain your approval.

That way we know no one is taking advantage of your membership without your knowledge.

### WAIVER

All Morning Lap Club swimmers must complete and sign a WAIVER (obtained at the pool) each calendar year before this can be started. Please adhere to the rules that were sent out. Thanks for your cooperation.

### POOL PARTIES

Pool Parties may be scheduled throughout the summer. A primary club member (adult) must attend these parties. Call Teresa Halsey to get information and availability. If a party is in your mind for mid to late August, please keep in mind that many of our lifeguards have returned to college, school has started, and school activities have begun and it is very hard to find people to work at this time.
