



Verona Weather Policy

Coaches and/or Verona Soccer Club (VSC) staff will suspend a practice, clinic, camp or event on the fields if they hear thunder or see lightning. All participants must move away from the fields and into a vehicle **immediately**. We ask that if there is a potential for storms on the radar, all parents or designated ride should remain at the field. Players and staff must stay sheltered away from the field until at least 30 minutes after the last detectable lightning or thunder.

During a game, the decision to stop, suspend or terminate a game lies exclusively with the assigned referee regarding any other severe weather conditions. Players and staff must leave the field immediately and seek shelter.

Field closures at Premier Soccer Fields

When the Verona Soccer club closes fields due to field conditions or inclement weather, we will try to update the club website, social media accounts and send out a club notification.

To keep up to date with the latest notifications, we recommend following VSC on more than one social media site (links below). The call to close fields on practice days will be made by 3:00 pm by the Verona Soccer Club fields coordinator. After 3:00 pm the decision will be from your coach. When VSC has been notified of a field closure an alert will be sent out immediately; please refrain from contacting VSC in regard to status of fields, as we will inform members as soon as we are aware of changes.
