



# Lord Palumbo's Kentuck Knob

#### **Celebrates 21 Years Open to the Public**

Lord Peter Palumbo chats with author Marci Lynn McGuinness about Kentuck Knob, the Frank Lloyd Wright home he fell in love with in 1985.

"Life, on occasion, becomes a matter of serendipity. When circumstances conspire to propel one in a certain direction, it is best to go with the flow, or so I have found, even if the precise destination is at the time unknown. My purchase of Kentuck Knob falls in this category." *Lord Palumbo* 

(From Forward of "Frank Lloyd Wright's House on Kentuck" by Donald Hoffman, 2000.)



When Lord Palumbo first arrived at Hagan's Kentuck Knob, the Frank Lloyd Wright house above Ohiopyle, there was no one there. "The house was waiting for me," he told McGuinness. "Fate was playing its hand. You should always go along with it in total agreement."

**It was 1985.** A long time art collector and owner of architecturally outstanding homes, he strongly felt, "The property should be loved, cherished and maintained as far into the future as anyone can see." Six weeks later, he purchased the home and lived there several months each year for a decade.

**Wright never visited** the site of Kentuck Knob before designing. The 86 year old had Bernadine and I. N Hagan visit him in 1954, interviewed them and said, "I'll shake a design out of my sleeve." In 1956, they moved into the one story Usonian home with a breathtaking view.

**In 1997, Peter and Hayat Palumbo opened** the masterpiece to the public. Today over 30,000 tour the home each year. Tour guides frequently hear visitors comment, "We love this house. We feel we could bring our pj's and settle right in."

#### "Pennsylvania is a most magical state," he shared.

"It is a great privilege and pleasure for the Palumbo family to own Kentuck Knob. It is very special, a work that is representative of the Usonian category by one of the world's most renowned architects."

The family dog, Lily, spent the afternoon with us, often greeting visitors. Kentuck Knob has a euphoric feel to it, a soft openness.

I thank the Palumbo's for caring for this southwestern Pennsylvania treasure.

(80 proof moonshine infused with Cinnamon and hints of vanilla.) Caramel, Banana Foster, Huckleberry, Root beer, Peach, Lumberjacked Apple, Café-Mocha, Apple Pie, Orange cream, Ma'rita, Rebellion and Forest Fire (140 proof Bourbon style). The Pine Top is straight up white lightening.

Come see how moonshine is made, have a free tasting and purchase unique merchandise in the shop.

Tall Pines is also home to the Bootlegger! A 2010 four-wheel drive Camaro. The Camaro is outfitted with an LS3 engine, Turbonetics turbo, Pitt Bull Tires, Fox suspension, full steel roll cage, racing seats, and a built-in smoke screen! No need to out run the law because Tall Pines is a legal distillery but with the rich moonshining history of the area you can't help but get caught up in the prohibition era! South Dakota. He placed 6<sup>th</sup> among 24 Super Late Models registered for the heat. This put him in 18th on the starting grid for the \$10,000-to-win A-Main. He passsed 8 cars and came in 10th.

The next night, Mason and crew were at Jackson Motorplex in Jackson, Minnesota for the Sturdevant's Auto Parts 50. He came in 2nd in his heat behind Bobby Pierce, earning him the 6th-starting position in

the A-Main. He came in 8<sup>th</sup>.

On Thursday night they traveled to the I-80 Speedway in Greenwood, Nebraska for the Malvern Bank Go 50. Mason placed 2nd behind Jimmy Owens. He started the feature in 6th, but a broken radiator on lap-4 *put him out of the running*.

Friday night Mason placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in his first heat race, then enjoyed an 11-lap heat race win.

He was ready for the Saturday night \$53,000-to-win Silver Dollar Nationals and had the car to beat, but a broken J-bar on lap-12 when he was in 2nd place ended his night.

### Ohiopyle's Annual Wine, Art & Music Fest Fundraiser for Borough Operations

Sewage has been a sore subject in the borough of Ohiopyle, Pennsylvania for over a decade. Their inadequate sewage system has been used by almost 2 million Ohiopyle State Park visitors each year. Most people in the area know this. Since the borough received "city water and sewage" in the mid 1960's, this has been the case.

Over the past ten years, several business people have filed for new hook ups, but there are absolutely none available. This problem has held off hotels, restaurants, coffee shops, and literally any new structure that requires a sewage tap.

On May 18, 2019, the non profit group formed solely to raise money for a sewage upgrade, will hold its fifth annual Spirit of the River, Ohiopyle Wine, Music & Art Festival. Lincoln Street and parts of Sherman are blocked off for winery and distillery tastings and art vendors. In the playground gazebo across from the community center, bands play and attendees gather, dance and enjoy.

The past two years the weather has been

delightful, hovering at 80 and sunny. Ohiopyle rocked and rolled and thousands were raised for the sewage cause. Recently businesses have come in and taken this sewage tap problem personally. The borough wants and needs new businesses. They work hard to keep the tiny village going for you. Join us in May, because without sewage, life is no festival.



#### Five Life Lessons Shared While Running with My Sons

In my most recent post, Five Things I Learned By Running with My Four-Year-Old Son, I listed the instinctual inclinations that Avie expresses as a runner. Here is part two of the story. Below is a list of the life lessons that my husband Eric and I share with Avie, age five, as well as his one and a half year old brother, Grey, during our runs together. They can be applied to any age of children and even adults!



1. Truly happy humans are untouched by weather conditions.

Dale Carnegie said it best: "Happiness doesn't depend on any external conditions - it is governed by our mental attitude."

It is of utmost importance that I raise two boys to become men who do not complain about the weather. Why? Because happiness lies within, and external factors such as weather cannot touch true contentment. Besides, hearing moans and groans about weather tires my spirit. So, when Avie looks outside and says something like, "mom, I think it's too cold to run," I respond with something like, "running will warm us up!" or "it's never too cold to run!" With that, we gather and clothe with proper apparel and gear and bolt outside!

2. It's not about being the fastest or the best.

"Let's go running!" I announce to the boys. "I'm going to be the fastest!" Avie replies. While he may be fast, and I do encourage his speed, I also explain that running is not about being the fastest or the best. It's about enjoying the company you keep on the run, the sun shining through the trees, the wind kissing the face,

the lungs expanding, the muscles working, the heart pumping, the sweat forming, the smile that physical movement brings to the soul and the satisfaction of a true and genuine effort. That's what running is about, no matter how fast one can go.

3. Excellent leaders come into position subtly, softly, with compassion and grace and by example.


It used to happen all the time. We would set forth on a run, and immediately Avie would shout, "I'm the leader!!!" if anyone passed him by. Anger would rise in his voice, and soon he'd be demanding that we all get behind him. Eventually I began describing how true leaders encourage others to follow - by hardly needing to say anything at all, by having a positive attitude and, most of all, by being kind to all beings, which means no bossing. It took months of leadership talk, but we have succeeded! Avie no longer panics if I or his dad passes him by. Rather, we all rotate and move along at various paces, taking turns leading, running back to one another, bringing up the rear and always finishing together.

4. Exercise paired with fresh air uplifts, refreshes and transforms.

When mid-afternoon slumps bring down the energy of the household or tantrums begin to escalate, a change of scenery is needed. Irritability, negative attitudes and poor listening (on Avie's part) and fussiness (on Grey's part) almost immediately resolve themselves upon stepping outside. Furthermore, channeling yucky energy into a simple, focused physical activity such as running transforms Avie's behavior as well as my own, and Grey maintains a focused calm as he watches us both in action. Avie has heard me say often, "I need to go for a run" and has witnessed me return with a calmer demeanor and clearer head. Now Avie has begun to say, "Mom, I need to put on my running shoes and run laps around the yard." He, too, comes back with more sense and peace about him. A win-win for all!

5."I can't" is counterproductive.

I'm an advocate of positive psychology, optimistic attitudes and a can-do attitude. So when Avie first uttered the phrase, "I can't" as we began running up a steep hill, my heart sunk (also because hill running is my personal favorite!). I countered his discouragement by sharing the story of "The Little Engine That Could." What we say we can do, we can do. And what we say we can't do, well, we can't. Our thoughts determine our words which determine our actions. These days I hear this phrase less and less often.

Slow Flow - 10 a.m., Friday, August 3, 17 & 31 and 5 p.m., and Wednesday, August 8, 15, 22 & 29

This all-levels flow (vinyasa) yoga class links breath with movement in a light and creative way.
