# Intercity League <br> $7^{\text {th }} \boldsymbol{\&} \mathbf{8}^{\text {th }}$ Grade <br> BASKETBALL RULES FOR GIRLS/BOYS 

(Revised 1-9-2019)

1. Girls and boys will play two halves consisting of 14 minutes each (not running time).
2. Pressing and Defense
A. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade " $A$ "
3. Teams follow regular rules
B. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade "B1" Teams must play man-to-man half-court defense.
4. Teams may press man-to-man the last 2 minutes of each half
C. 8th grade "B2" Teams must play man-to-man half-court defense.
5. Teams may press man-to-man the last 2 minutes of each half
D. $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade "A"
6. Teams must play man-to-man half-court defense and are allowed to press entire game in man-to-man defense.
E. $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade "B1"
7. Teams - must play man-to-man half-court defense.
F. 7th Grade "B2"
8. Team must play man-to-man half-court defense.
9. The overtime period (if needed) will be two minutes in duration. Continue overtimes until there is a winner.
10. Each team is allowed two full-length and two 20 -second timeouts during a regulation game.
11. The home team will provide basketballs for the visiting team. Beginning with the 2001 season, $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade boys will use an official-sized men's basketball.

On all rule interpretations, use common sense and a sense of fair play!
