### CITY BUSINESS

1. **Request for Rezone – Stanfield/Thompson - R1 to R2 approx. 5396 S. 4700 W.**

Marita Stanfield and Brian Thompson, property owners, have submitted a request for rezone of 2.35 acres for the purpose of future development.

Tracy Allen, City Engineer, presented the details of the Rezone request to Council.

**MOTION:** Councilman Cooke made a motion to approve the rezone request from R1 to R2 for the 2.35 acre property located at approx. 5396 s 4700 w. by the Stanfields. Councilman Hill seconded the motion. Councilman Cooke, Hill, and Paulsen voted "Aye". Motion carried.

2. **Approval for Release of Easement; Michael Taylor – 6061 W. 5900 S.**

A request for a release of the public utility easements running North and South through the property boundary of the Foy Subdivision has been made by Michael Taylor at 6061 W. 5900 S.

3. **Approval of Resolution R-2019-02 – Cooperative Agreement between Hooper City and Weber County regarding the 2019 and 2021 municipal elections.**

The purpose of the interlocal cooperation agreement between Weber County/Weber County Clerk’s Office, Elections Division and Hooper City is to provide the services of its Clerk’s Office, Elections Division, to the City for the purpose of assisting in conducting the City’s 2019 and 2021 primary and general municipal elections.

**MOTION:** Councilman Cooke made a motion to approve resolution R-2019-02 authorizing a cooperative agreement between Hooper City and Weber County for municipal election services. Councilman Hill seconded the motion. Councilman Cooke, Paulsen and Hill voted “Aye”. Motion carried.
