AN ORDINANCE

Adopting and Amending ordinance No. 2018-64 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) by appropriating from unappropriated funds in the General Fund, the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund, the Water Fund, and the Sewer Fund and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That ordinance No. 2018-64 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) passed December 18, 2018, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

SECTION 2: That Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-200-531700 General Fund – Public Health-Cemetery/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 3: That One Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$137,525) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-660-541999 General Fund – Transportation-Airport/Materials and Supplies-Repairs and Maintenance.

SECTION 4: That One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-740-531700 General Fund – General Government-Auditor/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 5: That One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 201-620-531700 Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund – Transportation-Street/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 6: That One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 501-510-531700 Water Fund – Basic Utility-Water Plant/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 7: That One Hundred Eight Thousand Dollars (\$108,000) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 501-515-559004 Water Fund – Basic Utility-Water Distribution/Capital Outlay-Infrastructure.

SECTION 8: That One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 520-520-531700 Water Fund – Basic Utility-WWTP/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.


SECTION 9: That this ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

SECTION 10: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 11: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Fostoria and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2019 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

THEREFORE, upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, and signature by Mayor, this ordinance shall take immediate force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE

Adopting and Amending ordinance No. 2018-64 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) by appropriating from unappropriated funds in the Sewer Fund and transferring funds for the Sewer and Water Extension Fund and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That ordinance No. 2018-64 (Permanent 2019 Appropriations) passed December 18, 2018, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

SECTION 2: That Three Thousand Seventy Four Dollars and Seventy Four Cents (\$3,074.74) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 520-900-573030 Sewer Fund – Transfers Out/Transfers Out.

SECTION 3: That Three Thousand Seventy Four Dollars and Seventy Four Cents (\$3,074.74) be transferred from 520-900-573030 Sewer Fund – Transfer Out/Transfers Out to Fund 492 – Sewer and Water Extension Fund.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

SECTION 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
