Preparation guide - rodent treatment

Before we arrive

- 1.) Talk with all the household members to find all that rats have been seen or heard.
- 2.) Pick up all pet food that is accessible to rats, and start feeding your pet at certain times, at least until the rat issue is resolved. Bird food is especially tasty and accessible to rats.
- 3.) Talk between adults and determine whether you would like a mechanical (kill) trap, or a sticky (live) trap. If you have small children, under 8, curious kids, or developmentally disabled children, you probably want to use a sticky trap, as mechanical traps are hazardous if improperly handled.

NOTE: Sticky traps will trap a live animal and it is imperative that you do not try to free and/or remove the animal, let pest control handle this, you can get bit

After we leave

- 1.) Inform family members as to the location of all traps, and instruct them what to do if an animal gets trapped (call pest control or manager)
- 2.) If you have not caught the rat after two weeks, and you still hear activity, talk to the manager, as we need to set a follow up to find an alternative method of control.
