MASS READING RELFECTION

September 27, 2020

1st Reading Ez 18:25-28
[Seek The Lord]

Among the first group of Hebrews deported to Babylon there was a priest and prophet called Ezekiel. As a wandering preacher, he went from one Jewish settlement to another, encouraging his people to have faith in God, but also correcting them when he found them guilty.

Human freedom implies full responsibility for what we do and should do. Only when I do not project my guilt onto somebody else and honestly admit “that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault....”(Penitential Act of Mass) can God forgive and show the mercy besought by the Responsorial Psalm.

2nd Reading Phil 2:1-11 or 2:1-5
[The Virtuous Man Shall Live]

Notice that Paul writes from his “imprisonment in Christ’s cause” (1:12). He worries about dissension, an evil that besets many congregations. “United in heart,” i.e., united in spirit and ideals—this should be the goal of all the members of your parish as well! Christ is the model, as described in the hymn Paul quotes in his letter.

In the last analysis, the individual person is responsible for living his own life and for "finding himself." If he persists in shifting his responsibility to somebody else, he fails to find out the meaning of his own existence.

THEME: Responsibility

Projection (“Not I, but he/she did it: he/she is responsible, not I”) is as old as the story of Adam and Eve. With great psychological insight the author of Genesis has Adam reply: “The woman... gave me fruit from the tree, and so I ate it.” And the woman answers: “The serpent tricked me into it, so I ate it” (Gn 3:12-13). Every teacher hears the same thing daily: “Not me! He/she did it!”

No one who goes to jail can be said to bear the total guilt for his/her crime. Past family upbringing and society also contribute to making persons what they are, but only a certain extent. In point of fact, free grown-up persons are responsible for what they do. Judges, lawyers, and psychologists wrangle daily with the tension between individual responsibility and the collective guilt of the environment.

Today’s Bible readings discuss this problem of sinful human beings related to God, their judge. We should be careful in judging others since we do not know how much a failing brother or sister is determined by his or her past; but knowing ourselves we should be realistic and accept full responsibility for what we do and should do!




