# ACT1 & ACT2

**Sunday, November 12, 2017**

Judging: 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM

**WCOTC Training Center**

**ACT1 is an entry level test that is designed to introduce dog and handler to the agility ring and basic agility obstacles.**

**ACT2 is the second level and designed to further introduce the dog and handler to the agility ring and additional agility obstacles.**

## **Who Can Enter**

- Any dog that meets the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial.
- Dog must be 15 months old or older.
- The dog cannot have earned any AKC agility title.
- Non-registered (can be registered day of event) or AKC registered Dogs without registration numbers will be issued a temporary one after the event by the AKC office.
- If a dog handler team has qualified at an event with an unregistered dog they will be sent a query to register the dog after the event.

## **How to Enter**

- Exhibitor can fill out an entry form on the day of event.
- Dog may enter both ACT1 and ACT2 on the same day
- Two ACT1 and Two ACT2 tests are offered so receiving a title is possible on the same day
- Cost is \$10 per entry for Pre-registered dogs and \$15 per entry for Day-of-Trial entries.
  - Pre-registration for our trials is preferred. Deadline for pre-registration is 11/8/2017.
  - You may register on the day of the trial between the hours of 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM.

## **Performance and Titles**

- Run a course at any height (ACT1 - 10-12 obstacles, ACT2 - 11-13 obstacles)
- Receive 2 qualifying legs to earn a title
- ACT1 and ACT2 titles can be achieved in one day if dogs qualify twice in the same class.
- ACT1 and ACT2 titles and certificates will be issued by the American Kennel Club to dogs that are registered with them.
- Qualifying and placement ribbons will be presented by WCOTC.
