A cursory analysis of the statistical data from this report should be demonstrative of the quality of performance of this agency in realizing the contractual obligations and the overall achievement of the goals and objectives of this Agency and the Toll Road Division.

A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 296 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. hours were exhausted on vacation time, workers compensatory, and COVID sick leave. 1.667 total miles were driven and the shift responded to 1082 total service calls. The shift issued 3 traffic warnings,


11 citations made 3 arrests and handled 17 enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is 3.8


Deputy Jolivette's grandfather passed away, compensatory off leave will be reflected on report because of this misfortune.








Security Checks Percentages & Trends









Trends and Percentages of Traffic




